

E-Learning Instructions

Access to internet is determined at enrollment meetings. If a student does not, the school will secure a hot spot for the family. If possible, teachers and staff will determine which students will need Chromebooks issued to them to be able to more easily complete work from home. Teachers and staff will bring home their laptops.

P.E.A.S.E. Academy has declared an E-Learning Day due to the weather. This means students participate in their classes virtually rather than coming to school. Here is the schedule:

8:30--9:15 1st hour
(9:15--9:45--students can move, clean up, eat breakfast, get dressed)
9:50--10:35 2nd hour
10:45--11:30 PST
11:40--12:25 4th hour
12:25--1:15 Lunch
1:20--2:05 5th hour
2:15--3:00 6th hour

Students will follow their same schedule, with the exception there will be no CHIME. Erica, Catherine and myself will be available throughout the school day (8:00--4:00) to answer questions, provide support, etc. Teachers will be available during the same hours.

For Science and Social Studies classes, students need to check in with Lois via Google chat at the beginning of the period, discuss what they'll accomplish in class period, and check in at the end about what they accomplished. Lois, as the other teachers, can google meet rather than chat.

For the Math and English classes, students need to check-in at the beginning, be engaged throughout if it is a live lesson. Or if it is reading/worksheet via google classroom, check in at the beginning of the hour and the end of the hour.

If students do not have access to the internet at home, we will provide an alternative, yet comparable assignment to the one they should be working on for their specific class.

Attendance is taken per period. To get attendance students need to show up for that hour as described above.

6th hour/elective hour, students will check in with their teacher to find out the plan. Sobriety Support Group will meet with Erica as a virtual SSG via video.
